## Anatomy & Physiology Dual Credit

offered in collaboration with Durham College

Dual credits allow adults aged 21 and over, working towards their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), the opportunity to reach ahead and take a free college course. The course qualifies for both high school and Durham College credit. It's highly recommended for students who wish to ease the transition to college by mastering DC connect (the online platform), learning success strategies, and getting a head-start. Class will be delivered using a hybrid model with in-school and on-line synchronous learning. Free tuition, transportation support, and a college application voucher are included for qualified accepted students.
