Dual Credit Programs: Offered in collaboration with Durham College

Dual credits allow adults aged 21 and over, working towards their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), the opportunity to reach ahead and take a free college course. The course qualifies for both high school and Durham College credit.
