## **REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR;**

Students <u>currently registered in a secondary day school in a school board other than the Durham</u>

<u>District School Board during the 2019/2020 academic year</u>

and

Students NOT registered in a secondary day school

#### STEP 1: IN PERSON REGISTRATION ONLY

Visit Durham Continuing Education, 120 Centre Street S., Oshawa, Mon. to Fri., 8:30 am to 3:30 pm (late office hours 4:30 to 6:30 pm on September 17 and 19, 2019 and Feb 3 and 5, 2020) to register, bring original documents. Please bring your receipt to the first class.

### \*Students MUST BRING ALL of the following at time of in person registration:

• Letter of Permission

(Only required by applicants currently attending a secondary school other than a DDSB school). Student <u>MUST</u> inform their home school guidance department and receive a letter of permission. The letter of permission must be on official school letterhead and include the student's legal name, date of birth, OEN number and academic course code choice.

• Canadian Citizenship Requirement:

(Required by all applicants & must provide one of the following as proof of Canadian residency)

- -Valid Canadian birth certificate
- -Valid Canadian passport
- -Valid landed immigrant or permanent resident documentation
- Official government photo identification (i.e. health card, driver's licence, etc.)
   (Required by all applicants)

**Step 2 (for Co-op students ONLY):** Submit the Co-op Placement Information Form to Durham Continuing Education by Wed. Feb. 2020 to complete registration.

Fees: Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents and Refugees - No Fee - \$0

**Non-resident Fee** (i.e. Visa student, students who reside out of country) **\$1875.00** per course, payable in full at time of registration (non-refundable) by cash, credit card, debit, money order. Personal cheques are not accepted.

### **Cancelled Courses:**

Students will not receive any communication from Durham Continuing Education unless the course is cancelled. The Durham District School Board reserves the right to close a class. Courses with insufficient enrollment are subject to cancellation on short notice.
