*Note: Considerations when registering;* 

- Pre-requisite courses apply for current secondary students. Adults may start at any level, however, it is recommended that regardless of language ability, students begin with Level 1.
- For any student wishing a "Certificate of Language Instruction", they must take all three (3) levels B, C, and D. Certificates are awarded in either the Open Level stream or the Academic/University stream as long as all three (3) levels have been completed.
- Open Level (O) courses will concentrate on spoken language and is best suited for those looking to learn a language in which they have no background or exposure.
- Academic/University Level (D/U) courses require that the individual have basic knowledge of the spoken language. The courses will concentrate on the more complex aspects of the spoken and written word including exploring novels, prose and other media in the language studied.
