Getting Ready for High School will be offered in a Remote Learning Delivery Model this year via Google Classroom. The program will run Monday August 24, 2020 and Tuesday August 25, 2020 from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM. We will contact all registered students with login instructions using the email addressed used when registering for the program. We will also post login instructions and further information on our website when it becomes available.

This program is open to all students entering grade 9 in a Durham District School Board school in Fall 2020 and provides them with a brief introduction to the grade 9 English and mathematics curriculum, as well as study skills, time management, and steps to success. The program also allows students to become familiar with secondary school and prepares them for the transition from elementary school to secondary school.

It is especially helpful for students who are experiencing some anxiety related to the upcoming transition.

This program will be delivered by qualified teachers and where possible teachers from the school in which the student will attend.
